


PRIORY NURSERY

It was lovely to welcome back so many smiling faces this morning, we hope you all had an enjoyable half term and we are looking forward to a busy second half of the summer term.

Before the holidays, the children enjoyed a trip to the library! They were all so well behaved and we were very proud of them. As we walked to the library we discussed road safety and how traffic lights work, some of the children even had a turn at pressing the traffic light buttons. Once we arrived at the library, the children were able to freely choose some books to look at and also read with their teachers. They all understood the importance of using their indoor voices and how to put the books away once they had finished. Finally, we all sat down together to listen to a story before heading back to nursery.



In the literacy zone the children enjoyed using the stencils to create pictures and then choosing which colours they wanted to use to complete their pictures. They also enjoyed exploring the 'Seaside' tray which consisted of water, sand, shells and ice creams. There were lots of discussions and conversations about their own experiences and what they had seen.

In the maths zone the children were able to get messy in the exploration tray! They thoroughly enjoyed discovering what happened when cornflour, paint and water is mixed together. They then used the mixture and tools to scoop, fill and empty different containers.

In the creative zone, the free painting was particularly popular. The children enjoyed selecting their own colours and tools to create their own representations of people, objects and places. They also participated in imaginative play whilst exploring the playdough, they became chefs for the day and enjoyed making 'cakes' for their friends and teachers.
