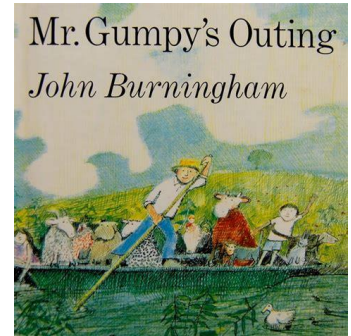
## Peek at the Week
