


PRIORY YEAR 2

Dear Parents/Carers,

Well done to all the Year 2 children who have had a successful first week in their new classes!

Next week, in our English lessons we will begin to explore our new class book – *The Tiger Child* by Joanna Troughton. We will use drama to learn more about how the different characters in the book feel and we will begin to retell the story using story actions. We will also be focusing on writing using descriptive vocabulary.

In Maths we will be continuing our unit on place value. The children will continue with partitioning numbers into tens and ones.

Our Science topic is Materials this half term and the children will be investigating the properties of different everyday materials.

Your child has been given a reading book and a weekly planner this week. Please can you ensure that he/she comes to school with both their reading planner and reading book daily to ensure that they receive new books during the week.

Mathletics homework is set on a Friday in Year 2 and the children are given a week to complete tasks. The first task will be set on Friday 14th September.
