



Dear Parents/Carers,

In English, the children have planned their adaptation of 'The Tiger Child' and they have used their story maps to retell their story. We have started writing our story and, next week, they will continue. When writing, the children will focus on using story words, similes, good verbs, conjunctions and adjectives to make their writing more interesting. The children will also be encouraged to take time to check and edit their writing.

This week in Maths, the children have been ordering, comparing and positioning numbers on a number line. In addition, we have practised reading and writing numbers to 100. We will now move onto adding two 2-digit numbers by drawing a number line. In CLC, the children have compared, they compared the jobs of past and present fire fighters.

During our Science lesson, the children completed an investigation. They were given a range of objects and had to closely observe them to identify their properties.

Finally, the children will have a trip to Windsor Castle on the 18th October. Please can you ensure that you have returned the completed permission slip to your child's class teacher. We will be returning in time for the end of the school day. Your child needs to be in school uniform, wearing sensible shoes and a waterproof coat in case of bad weather. Activity to try at home

Use coins to practise counting in 10's. Put a small amount of coins in a container and add 10p coins one at a time. Encourage your child to count-up in 10s. For example, you could start with 6p and then every time you drop a 10p coin you count-up in 10's e.g. 6p, 16p, 26p, 36p and so on. Ask your child to close his/her eyes to make it more fun.
