


# PRIORY NURSERY

Dear Parent/Carer

Last week the children were able to meet the stick insects! They helped Mrs Hill to fill their tank with fresh leaves and twigs and we discussed how to look after them. Some of the children were even brave enough to hold them! If there are any parents/children who would like to look after the stick insects over the weekend or during the holidays please speak to Mrs Hill.



In the maths zone the children thoroughly enjoyed exploring the slime. They watched how it would slide off the toys and their hands if they tried to pick it up or scoop it into a container. The children were using various words to describe the slime such as gooey and slimy.

In the literacy/communication room the children were able to use the dressing up clothes and occupation equipment. They were having discussions about hairdressers, doctors, vets etc. Some of the children were sharing with each other where their parents work and what they do. In the creative zone, the children enjoyed creating their own pictures using a variety of materials and resources such as tissue paper, cardboard, glue and scissors.

We also showed the children the nursery cameras last week. They took it in turns to take pictures of themselves or the room and then look through the photos at the end. The children were able to find out how to turn them on and explore the different functions of the camera.

If you celebrate Diwali and have any fabric, objects, food packaging or pictures we would be grateful if parents would bring in some examples that they do not mind us borrowing to share with the children next week. Thank you!
