Dear Parent/Carer

Last week the children really settled into the Nursery routines and are becoming more familiar with what happens day to day.

The children were able to learn all about Autumn last week. We looked at what happens during Autumn, what colours we might see and what might happen to the weather. They all enjoyed sharing their ideas and own experiences in relation to Autumn with the whole group. If your child finds anything related to Autumn whilst outside, please feel free to send the items into nursery which we can look at during carpet time. Conkers, leaves etc. We have attached a list of Autumn words which we thought of as a group, if you could look at these and reinforce them during conversations at home it will help develop your children's vocabulary.

In the creative zone the children enjoyed using the playdough to make us 'pancakes' last week! They explored the tools and were experimenting with how they could make different marks in the playdough. The home corner was also popular with the children creating an ice cream shop and also looking after the babies.

In the maths and investigation zone the children were able to explore the tuff tray which contained bugs, frogs, water and magnifying glasses. The marble run was also very popular, the children worked together to build a maze and were taking turns to use the marbles.

The literacy/communication zone was very busy with children acting out the role of firemen! They enjoyed finding the 'fires' and putting them out with their 'water hoses'. The children were also interested in the construction area and were fixing cars whilst being 'mechanics'.

Please ensure that you hand any important letters to your child's teacher as we don't always have time to look through all the children's bags during the day.

Every week the library book trolley will be available for you and your child to swap over a reading book. Please write your child's name and the book that you have chosen.
