


PRIORY YEAR 2

Dear Parents/Carers,

This has been a really exciting week in Year 2 because on Tuesday we were lucky enough to have a visit from the Royal Berkshire Fire and Rescue Service. One of the highlights for the children was being able to sit inside the fire engine which they particularly enjoyed. However, the children were also fascinated to learn about the different uniforms the fire fighters wear to protect themselves as well as the range of equipment they use.

In English this week the children have written their own versions of 'The Tiger Child'. They have focused on using story language, good adjectives and conjunctions to extend sentences. The children have also been encouraged to check and edit their writing.

In Maths the children have been adding pairs of two 2-digit numbers using a blank number line and with practise they are becoming more confident with this method. Next week we will be focusing on time and as part of this unit we will concentrate on reading times on an analogue clock.

This week in Science the children have used their knowledge of materials and their properties to design a special box to protect a fragile object. In RE they have explored the theme of kindness through the story of 'The Good Samaritan' and they enjoyed discussing ways they can be caring towards others every day at home and at school.

Recently, we have noticed that quite a few children with long hair have been wearing it loose and we would like to politely remind you that all long hair should be tied back.

The children have a reading book, spellings to learn and Mathletics tasks have been set.
