


# PRIORY NURSERY

Dear Parent/Carer

Last week the children enjoyed learning and talking about Remembrance Day whilst in nursery. We spoke about why and how we celebrate the day and some children shared with us, what they had done/seen over the weekend. The children then participated in a range of activities related to Remembrance Day across the nursery to further support their learning.

In the literacy/communication zone the children enjoyed creating their own writing den, they chose which writing materials they wanted to use and then worked together to create their pictures. They also explored the tuff tray, which had been filled with sand and were using the vehicles to create different marks and shapes.

In the maths zone, the children explored the kinetic sand using their hands, bowls and 'ice cubes'. They were able use the sand to hide objects and let their friends find them. We also looked at counting different objects and the ways we can represent these on paper, fingers etc.

In the creative zone, the children thoroughly enjoyed painting rocks for our creative day! These will be sent home with instructions of what to do on the newsletter. We also listened to a variety of music and looked at different ways we can move/dance depending on the type of music and rhythm of the beat

We are now doing show and tell on a Friday. Your child can bring a picture or toy from home they wish to share with their group.

**Top Tip** – to create things at home with your child, modelling how to use scissors and glue. We encourage children to bring in things they have made at home so we would love to see their creations!
