


PRIORY YEAR 2

Peek at the Week



Dear Parents/Carers,

In English, the children have worked really hard on their own George and the Dragon stories and have produced some lovely written work.



Next week, we will move onto our new unit – poetry. We will be using the book 'Tell me a Dragon' to generate ambitious vocabulary to use in a description of a dragon.

In Maths, we will be focusing on multiplication. The children will be recognising, making and adding equal groups focusing on the 2, 5, 3 and 10 times tables.

In Science, the children have been creating their own creature that can live in a habitat of their choosing. Once they designed their unusual animal, they had to explain how it keeps warm, moves, catches food and protects itself from predators. In addition, they had to think about why the animal is suited to the environment they chose.

Please can you ensure that your child brings his/her school diary to school daily, especially on a Friday so that they can receive a copy of their weekly spellings.

The children have received a S.P.A.G activity mat for homework today. This activity will be set weekly and please can it be completed by Thursday each week.

Activity to try at home

Use coins to practise counting in 10's. Put a small amount of coins in a container and add 10p coins one at a time. Encourage your child to count up in 10s. For example, you could start with 6p and then every time you drop a 10p coin you count up in 10's e.g. 6p, 16p, 26p, 36p and so on. Ask your child to close his/her eyes to make it more fun. Challenge – Can they count backwards?
