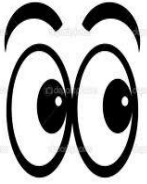


PRIORY YEAR 2

In Maths this week, we have been use Cuisenaire rods to help us with our addition and subtractions skills. Next week, we will move onto subtracting two 2-digit numbers by drawing an empty number line.
