

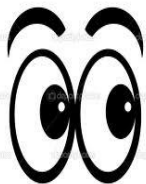
# PRIORY YEAR 2

In English this week the children have begun to write their own stories inspired by George and the Dragon. Once the stories have been finished, we will focus on editing the grammar, punctuation and descriptive language. Our next class text will be Tell Me a Dragon by Jackie Morris.

In Maths this week, as part of our current unit about money, the children have focused on adding combinations of pounds and pence. Next week they will learn how to calculate change from amounts up to £1. They will also start to compare amounts of money using  $<$ ,  $>$  and  $=$ .

In Science the children have compared two contrasting wetlands habitats. They have focused on how pond and ocean habitats provide for the basic needs of different plants and
