What a brilliant first week back in year 1!

Over this week in English we have started to look at the book 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey. Our aim for the end of the half term is to write a report about Traction Man. During this week we have started to look at the features of non-fiction writing, writing labels, captions and lists.

During maths this week we have started to lay out objects using statements and create repeated addition number sentences from what we have done.

In science we have begun to look at the seasons, and how the length of days and weather changes depending on the time of year. Each class is sending home a bear every day. The bear goes to bed at sunset and wakes up at sunrise, and will demonstrate to the children how the days are getting longer.

In ICT we have started to program on an iPad using the program 'espresso coding', making objects move around in different ways.

Next week we will continue to look at the seasons, and will start to look at hot and cold places.
