Beetles: Working with independence

Amount of children: 9

Staff: -Class teacher –x1 HLTA/ SSA - x 5 LSAs (including X2 1-1 adults).

Needs of children:

The children in this class are working more confidently within their academic learning. As with any class, the academic levels are varying and therefore, interventions are being set up to support certain pupils with their Phonics etc. The class has been grouped together based on their social skills and their readiness for integrating into the Mainstream setting. Personalised integration plans are in place for those individuals in the class whom this is relevant for. This year, more time is being given to building independence and life skills for these pupils e.g. buying travel tickets.

Strategies used:

Visual timetables; Makaton; 'life skills' sessions; out of class social learning; integration into Mainstream sessions for those who are ready; use of O.T equipment; daily O.T activities; academic interventions; social skills practice; movement breaks; SALT; Peer mentoring play sessions with Caterpillars class; 1-1 ELSA for specific pupils; 1-1 Art Therapy for a specific pupil; personalised timetable for individual pupil; class behaviour system.
