Needs of children:

The children in this class are working towards both academic and social targets. They have a lot of table-top time during their day and have a lot of adults to model and support during learning activities. This year, more time is being given to focus on developing the life skills and independence for these children.

Strategies used:

British Sign Language (for a specific child); Makaton; visual timetables; emotional check-ins; SALT; social skills practice; sensory play; social skills practice; Attention Autism; O.T equipment; PECS; Shape Coding; Lego Club for specific pupils; 1-1 Art Therapy for a specific pupil.
