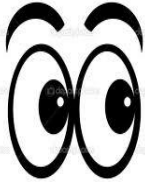


PRIORY RECEPTION

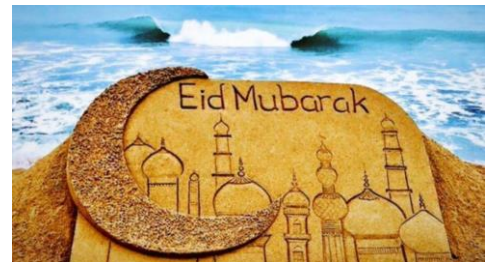

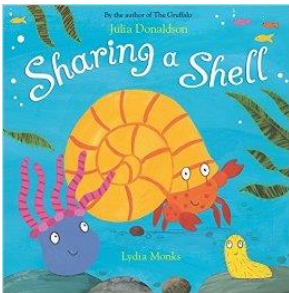
Dear Parents/Carers

We have started one of our busiest terms and certainly the most fun as we dive into the sea to learn all about the ocean and its' creatures.

We also hope that all the families celebrating Eid had a wonderful holiday.



In the Creative zone, the children have made sea creatures using a variety of craft materials. In the communication zone, the children have written a list of sea creatures and a sentence about what they see in the park. Lastly, in the investigation zone the children have been reviewing numeracy skills by completing equations and trying out number bonds to 10.



Our story next week will be '*Sharing a Shell*' by Julia Donaldson. We will also be reading a story to prepare for Father's day and talk about what we like about our dads, uncles or grandpas.

Phonics: We are continuing to review phase 2 and 3 to build a strong foundation going into Year 1.

This term is full of transition to help the children prepare for year 1. This includes less continuous provision and more sit down work at tables. For maths, we are concentrating on writing numbers and equations. For literacy, we are writing more in books and encouraging multiple sentences.
