- ❖ Provide pupils with individual resources where possible.
- ❖ Increase cleaning of the school site.
- ❖ Introduce social distancing measures and staggered drop off and collection times.
- ❖ Amend the behaviour policy to incorporate Covid 19 pandemic.
- ❖ Isolate anyone displaying symptoms and send them home quickly.
