

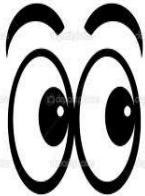

Dear Parent/Carer

The children have had another fantastic week in the Nursery. They have coped really well with their sessions and have got fully involved with all the different activities the Nursery has to offer.

This week the children have enjoyed decorating 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' for our display board using tissue paper and pens. They were all so keen to join in with re-telling the story through repetitive phrases and actions, the adults were all so impressed! The writing/mark making area was also very popular with some of the children who wanted to use the pens and pencils to create pictures to take home. It is great to see the children have formed friendships and are beginning to practice their sharing and turn taking skills whilst playing in the communication/literacy zone. They enjoyed exploring the tuff tray which had been filled with sand, pirate ships and gems; whilst creating different scenarios as a group and taking turns to use the pirate ship. In the maths zone the children were able to explore a variety of Autumn themed sensory materials, they talked about the natural resources and were able to point some of them out in the outdoor area and when we went around the mile a day track.

Please can you ensure your child has a spare set of clothes at Nursery in case they get wet/dirty or have an accident. Also, it would be really helpful if your child had shoes they can put on and do up themselves e.g. velcro not laces.

Each week, we will be choosing a child of the week – we will be sending a story sack with 3 books for you to enjoy on a Friday, Saturday and Sunday. We ask that you return this on Monday so that the items can be kept away for up to 72 hours. We can then have this ready and set up to send out for the next child of the week.

Top Tip – Support your child putting their shoes on independently showing them which is the left/right.
