



Dear Parent/Carer,

The children have been involved in to lots of different activities this week. It has been great to see the children spend as much time in the outdoor. As the weather is much colder, please do remember to send in a suitable coat, woolly hat, gloves and scarf and ensure that your child's name is written clearly on the label.

Here are some of the activities that the children have taken part in: In the creative zone, the children helped draw the bears from the story on zippy wallets full of paints! They also used different materials, tissue paper, wool, paint etc to help decorate a picture of Goldilocks and the Bear's house. The children particularly enjoyed using the scissors to snip along the edges of the card to make leaves. It was great to see so much concentration on their faces!

In the maths zone, the children loved exploring different media and materials including wet spaghetti, pink porridge oats and mark making in cornflour and water. They used toy frogs to help sing along to '5 little speckled frogs' where they took one frog away each time and helped count how many were left. They also had a selection of different objects, 3D shapes, bottle lids, beads etc to see what shape was printed on the paper.

In the literacy/communication zone, the children used markers and picked out magnetic letters to draw around or try to write. They helped re-tell last week's shared reading book 'The Farm Concert' with small world toys and imitated the adults with using the big book and using the pictures to help re-tell the main events to their friends. The children have continued to take part in activities around the core book 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' where they have helped sequence pictures in the correct order of the story.

In Shared Reading this week, we introduced the book 'Dear Zoo' and talked about any pets the children may have at home. They were very good at sharing this with the rest of their friends. We also talked about how we would send a letter to the zoo and what we would write on the letter first. We are continuing to point out basic features of a book: holding a book the correct way, knowing where the front cover of the book is, pointing out the words and the pictures.
