Y6 French – LO to label parts of the body in French.

Go to <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=XBoBwgigNOo>

Play the clip of the song several times.

Compare the words in the song with the vocabulary you learned last week at <https://www.french-games.net/frenchtopics> in the topic 'Body' and the section 'Parts of the Body'.

On a piece of A4 paper draw a body outline and label all the different parts of the body mentioned in the song and from last week. Some body parts are mentioned in the game and in the song – don't repeat these.

Count how many different parts of the body you now have the words for and email the answer to Y6. (eg 'eyes' counts as one, 'la tête' counts as one – you count the different body parts not all the individual words like 'la' and 'les'.)

Challenge

There are lots of different examples of the song. Look at a different example – can you learn the song and keep up with the people in this example?

(This version is for teaching young French children the parts of the body, so although it is intended for younger children it is still interesting to see and hear real French people.) Instead of just saying 'the eyes and the ears' they sing 'I have two eyes, two ears.'
