Coding Club for this term will be for Minecraft Java Programming Porkshop Part 1 and is available for children in Years 1–6. It is suitable to all primary school children year 1-6 as we have different challenges for different year groups. Please see brief outline below:

At Jam Coding, our goal is to help improve children's digital skills. Our Minecraft club consists of different challenges based in the Minecraft program. This workshop will teach children to work in teams, think logically, explore their creativity and solve problems whilst developing their computing and coding skills in Java language. Suitable for Minecraft experts as well as total newbies to the game. Build, craft and code in a fun, safe environment! At the end of the course, all children will receive a certificate and one team will receive a trophy!

Please can you inform us before booking if your child has any specific needs (i.e. has EHCP or SEN needs), this is important to ensure that the correct supervision is in place.

If your child is taking a KS2 football club shin pads are essential and football boots (no metal studs) are highly recommended, KS1 will just need PE Kit and trainers.

If you wish to allow your child to walk home alone after the club or want them to go to In2Care please follow this link: After School Clubs Spring 1 - January/February 2026 - Fill out form and complete the form otherwise we will assume they are being collected.

Some clubs have very limited numbers and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. If your payment is accepted on ARBOR, this is confirmation that your child has a place on the club requested. We also keep a waiting list and if a space becomes available, the next person on the list will be contacted.

Please note in the case of heavy rainfall, outdoor clubs will be held indoors.

Children will need to be collected promptly at 4.15pm. If you are continuously late, this may affect your child being able to attend future clubs.

If you are driving, for the safety of the children, please use the Visitors' Car Park and walk round; do not use the Staff carpark when collecting your child(ren).
