New experiences and confidence building

For some children, this may be their first time exploring Burnham Beeches – a beautiful local woodland. Experiencing new environments helps children build confidence, independence, and curiosity about the world around them.

A meaningful opportunity for pupil voice

Children will have the chance to speak directly with a member of SLT in an informal, natural setting. These conversations will help us understand their views on school, what they enjoy, what matters to them, and how we can continue to improve. Their voices will genuinely help shape the future of Priory School.

Life experience, not just school experience

These walks reflect our belief that school should offer moments children remember – opportunities that widen horizons, strengthen relationships, and create a sense of belonging and trust.

- Take place on Tuesday afternoons starting the week beginning 26th January
- A one-off experience – your child will go once only
- Each walk will include 4 pupils, 2 adults (Mrs Larkins + one SLT member)
