Orchard News

This week in Literacy, Apples and Plums have been continuing building/matching sentences using colourful semantics and have used PECs and communication boards to request desired items and using 'more' and 'stop' requests.

Cherries have been finishing sentences of differences and similarities between cars and trains in writing. In reading the children have worked in groups and answered question about a train.







In Maths, Apples and Plums have been continuing adding two groups of single digits together, sequencing double digits and practicing their skills in one to one correspondence, counting amounts 1-20 to coincide with our topic Tremendous Transport.

Cherries have played interactive games with 100's 10's and 1's and have been working in groups to create a number line, compare and order numbers to 20.




