Good afternoon all,

Eid Mubarak!

Wishing everyone who is celebrating a very happy Eid! Enjoy the feasts and festivities after a month of fasting and reflection.

This week at Priory: I popped into Reception this week and saw some very impressive writing that they were doing. I saw Year 1 enjoying their PE lessons with their teachers for the first time! I have been teaching in Year 2 and they have blown me away with their dividing skills. Year 5 had a rather exciting visit from the fire service and Year 6 continue to work hard to revise everything they have learnt to apply all that knowledge in their SATs.

This week we have had a phonics audit completed, we can be very confident that our pupils are receiving quality teaching of reading and are making good progress. Well done to the early reading team and the teachers teaching phonics.

We have continued to plan our school celebrations for the King's coronation. On Friday 5th May, children will have a special 'picnic' lunch and spend the afternoon completing coronation activities to mark the special occasion

Asthma advice: before Easter we had an email from the Pediatric Respiratory Nursing Team advising us that we must alert a parent every time a child uses their salbutamol inhaler. This will be tricky for some staff to call every time, however, we must do what we can to follow that advice.





I have advised staff to use their judgement and if they are satisfied that the child is absolutely fine and the taking of their inhaler is routine, they can leave it to the end of the day or drop the parent a quick email. If the staff member notices that the child needs their inhaler more often than they usually do, they are to make a call home as soon as possible.

Lots of children are diagnosed with Asthma, most children manage their asthma very well. However, this can mean that we do get a bit complacent when it comes to children needing their inhaler. We must never underestimate the seriousness of asthma and how quickly an asthma attack can occur and how quickly a child can deteriorate during an asthma attack. If you have concerns about your child's asthma do get in touch with the school to make sure their care plan is updated with the information we need.
