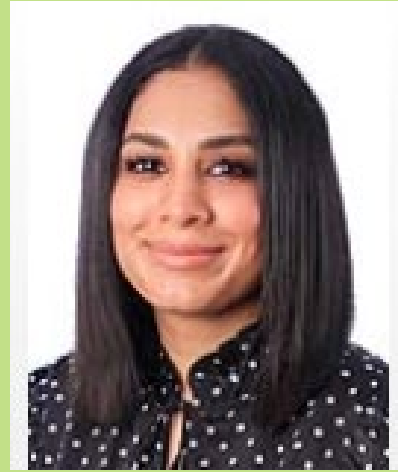

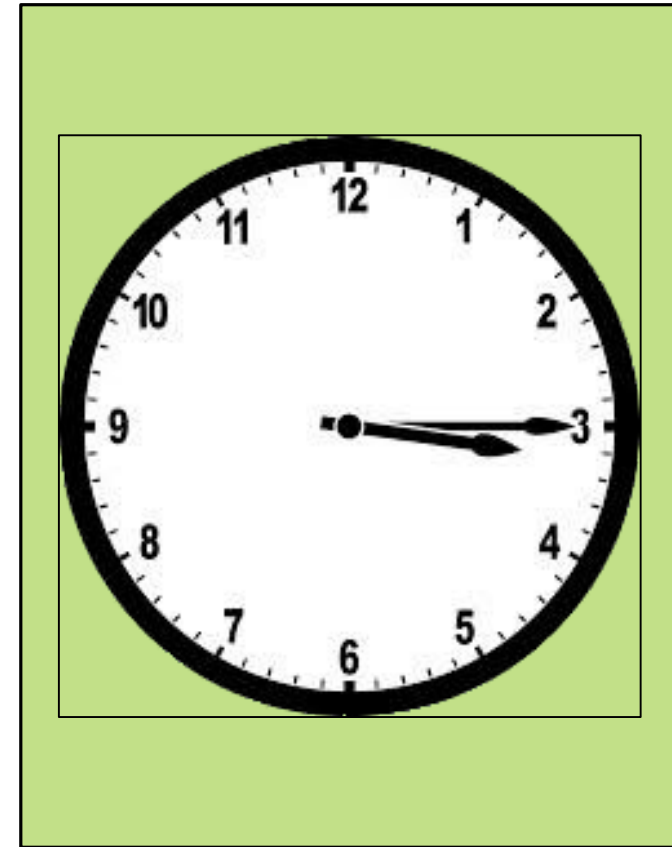

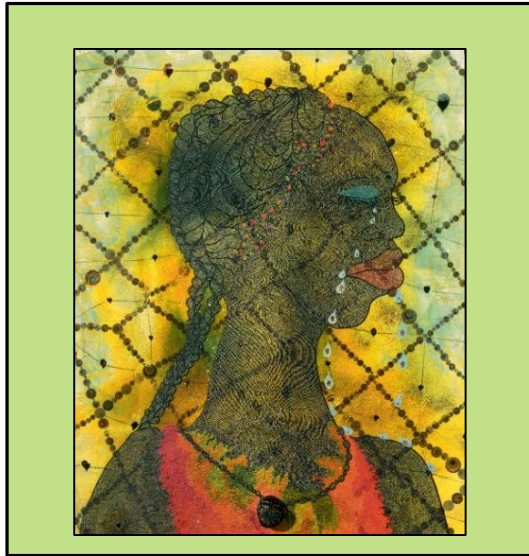
In the mornings, I will walk round to the KS2 playground and come into school the same way that I did in Year 4.

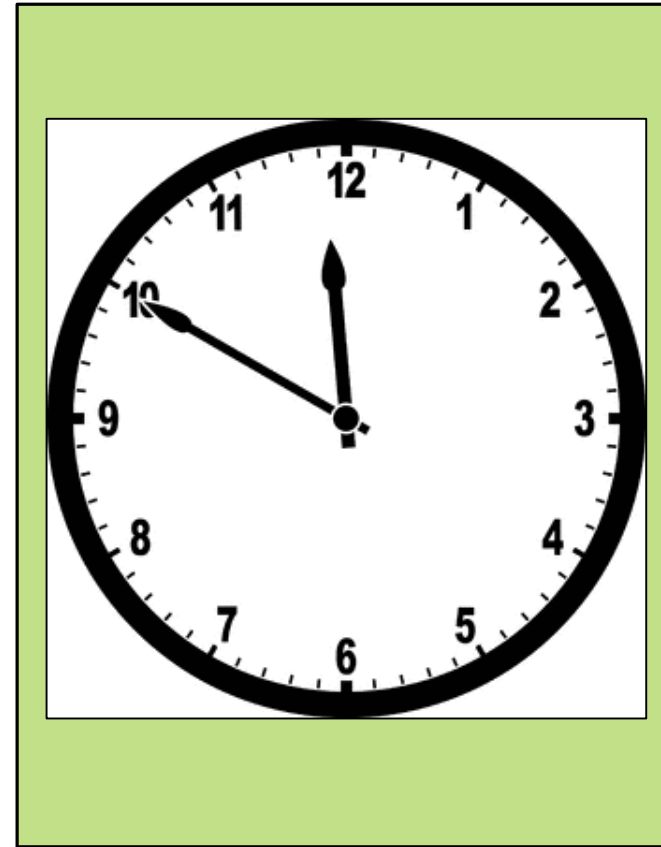
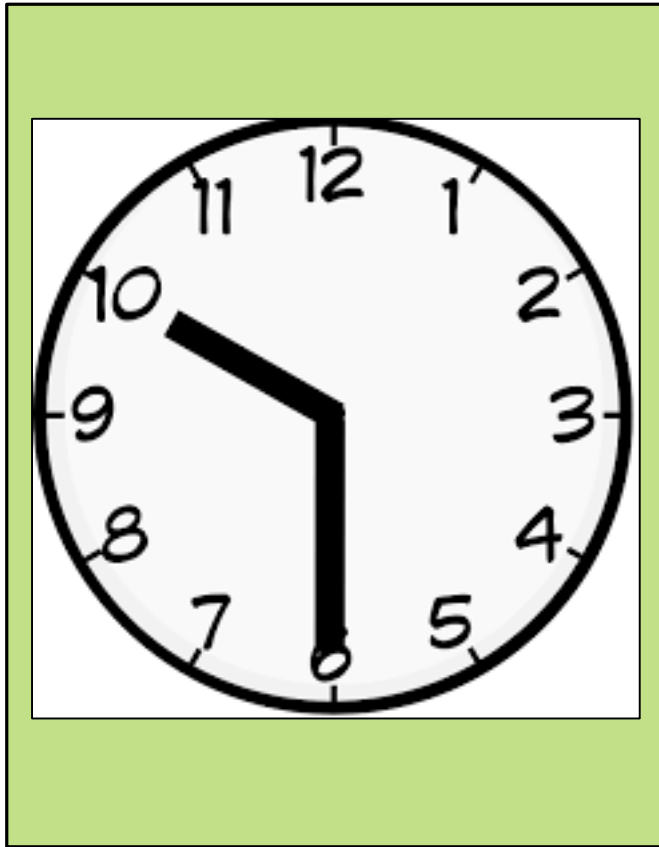
