Statutory Assessments

Multiplication tables check (MTC)

- Completed online in school during June.
- Please avoid taking your child out of school during this time and in the weeks leading up to the test.
- The children will be tested to determine whether they can recall **all of their times tables** fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics.

Homework – Core Skills

- Read with your child every day for at least 20 minutes and **record this in their Reading Record.**
- Spellings
- Times Tables Rockstars – each child will be given their login to complete this online.

How can you help...?

- Encourage your child to read **every** day. Record what they have read in their Reading Record and make sure your child brings their Reading Record into school every day.
- Encourage your child to read from a wide range of genre – fiction, non fiction, newspapers, the internet, comics, poems, leaflets.
- Talk to your child about what they are reading.
- Share a story with your child.

How can you help?

- Help your child practise their spellings and to learn the statutory words for Year 3/4 (a copy can be found on the Year 4 class page of the website).
- Encourage your child to practise their times tables every day – Rock Star Maths.

- Library books can be renewed each Tuesday.
